Cost: 15 day trip:

Early Bird before June 15: \$2,950.00 After June 15: \$3,500.00

Included: Round-trip airfare from departing airport in N.C. (probably Asheville) to Nairobi Kenya with team members, Room in a comfortable Guest House in Nairobi and Namanga, meals (except for lunch outside the Guest House), ground transportation while in Kenya, One day Safari at the Nairobi National Wildlife reserves, Giraffe Center Reserves Day, Dinner and Entertainment at Carnivores Restaurant, Training Day (June 6th) in Beautiful Pisgah National Forest, N.C. with Barbecue lunch and refreshments, Reunion and Debriefing October 17th with Thanksgiving meal celebration, team t-shirt, training manual and travel journal. Team Training includes: Foreign Missions 101; Health and Safety; Cultural Sensitivity and Awareness; History of Maasai; Packing for the Mission Field; Returning with Joy.
